

Due to his dedication and perseverance Zach was able to secure a new career at The Porch Factory. He is using skills he already acquired in the Navy along with learning new skills and a trade at The Porch Factory.

The Porch Factory let us know that "Zach is doing well and picking up on what is required for his position. He is friendly, working at an acceptable pace and doing well learning a new trade. We are happy to have him as part of our team."

We are so proud of Zach and all he has accomplished so far. There is no place for Zach to go but UP!

In 2023 the STEP program in St. Lucie County graduated 64 participants and helped 34 graduates find employment, with their combined incomes being just over \$849,000 St. Lucie County is going UP!
