With over 25,000 households engaged in our UPlifting programs, we reached new heights in the Success Training Employment Program (STEP), Crisis Stabilization, and Member Share Grocery initiatives. We launched a new workforce training program, Build UP, and opened up the county's first Multi-Agency Resource Center after Hurricane Milton tornadoes tore through.

In a county where 56% of residents struggle to afford basic needs, our mission is more critical than ever. Your unwavering support fuels our ability to expand services, launch new partnerships, and create life-changing opportunities for those who need them most. We are honored to serve this community we all cherish.

## WHERE ARE THEY NOW?

There comes a moment in life when we realize that simply getting by is not enough. That moment came for Matt when he found himself stuck in a job that barely covered the essentials. Then he saw an opportunity. A few people he knew had taken STEP and changed their lives for the better. Their success inspired him, and he thought to himself, "What if I could do the same?".

With that in mind, he took a leap of faith and enrolled in the next STEP cohort.

Today he can hardly believe how much his life has transformed. As of April, he will have been with Piper for two years. In that time, he had gone from living at Dynamic Life Sober Living Community to having his own apartment. He now has a driver's license, a reliable vehicle, and most importantly, financial freedom.

Matt says, "I owe a huge thank you to United Against Poverty and Dynamic Life for believing in me when I struggled to believe in myself. They opened doors I once thought were sealed shut, giving me the chance to step into a new life. On May 10th, I will celebrate three years of sobriety. That milestone is not just a number—it's a testament to faith, perseverance, and the power of transformation."

### **Thank You to Gerstner Philanthropies**

In 2024, United Against Poverty IRC was honored to receive a generous \$150,000 grant from Gerstner Philanthropies. This grant was specifically designated to assist families in crisis, helping them transition to stable living conditions. Thanks to this support, we were able to assist 66 households in overcoming their challenging circumstances. One recipient was a woman who had recently graduated nursing school. She was living in her car with her two teenage daughters. She finally secured employment in her field; however, she was unable to save enough for the upfront costs of stable housing. The crisis department was able to assist her with move-in money, and today she and her daughters have a home of their own, providing them with the stability to thrive.

The impact on these 66 families has been profound. We are thrilled to announce that this success has led to an additional \$390,000 grant from Gerstner Philanthropies to continue our mission over the next two years.

Gerstner Philanthropies is committed to supporting strong organizations focused on stabilizing households facing a one-time financial crisis. "We are proud to partner with United Against Poverty to expand our Helping Hands program, strengthening homelessness prevention and crisis intervention efforts in new communities," said Molly Gelinas, Program Officer at Gerstner Philanthropies.


